



Annual Build Day helps people in need in Bisbee, Naco

BISBEE — About 75 volunteers spread across the Bisbee and Naco area on Saturday to help those in need during the annual Step Up Bisbee/Naco Build Day.


Two organizations and seven residents received free assistance to make repairs — some basic and some more complex — to buildings and homes in an effort to significantly improve quality of life for the people who live there. Volunteers at the Verhelst Recovery House, a drug and alcohol rehab facility for men, made heating duct repairs, replaced windows and installed flower beds, while those at the Tin Town Homeless Shelter constructed new bunk beds for bedrooms. Private residents in the area received helping hands to repair heating systems roofs and more.

“We’ve got lawyers, doctors, neuroscientists, teachers, retirees and millionaires here today,” said Step Up Bisbee/Naco president Grady Meadows, who organized the Build Day. “People from all walks of life have volunteered.”

Many of the 75 volunteers were returners from previous Build Days, several from back when the event was organized under the national initiative Rebuilding Together, but Meadows said about 10 were brand new volunteers this year. In his spare time, Meadows has been teaching women at the Renaissance House drug and alcohol rehabilitation center how to make furniture. Eight of those women put those construction skills to work on Saturday.

One of the residents receiving help Saturday was a double amputee in a wheelchair, and another was an elderly woman in Naco who hasn’t had heat in her house in 30-plus years of living there. Projects are chosen through an application process.

Noah Suby, who owns a construction business in Bisbee, was the house captain for the Verhelst House projects. Along with him were seven individual volunteers assigned to that site as well as 10 of the men who currently live in the house. Their major project was installing a channel drain to direct rainwater away from the house to end the regular bouts of flooding on the porch and inside the structure.



"I love helping Bisbee," Suby said. "It's such a community-oriented town that always pulls together — for any cause. I feel like I can give back with expertise. It feels good doing this here, because we have a lot of participation by the people who are living in the house. They have some knowledge, and it's nice to have guys enthusiastic about helping to fix up this place."

Step Up Bisbee/Naco is a year-round effort that not only provides cleanup and repair work for homes and nonprofits in need each year, but also helps supply hot water, electricity, and indoor plumbing to those in need, focusing primarily on the low-income, elderly and disabled members of the community.

This **AGREEMENT** ("Agreement") is entered into this _____ day of _____, _____, by and between the **ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING, OFFICE OF MANUFACTURED HOUSING** ("OMH") and the City of Bisbee ("Agency").

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-4002 the purpose of OMH is to maintain standards of quality and safety for manufactured homes, factory-built buildings, mobile homes, and the installation of the same.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 41-4004 (B) (5) directs OMH to enter into agreements with local enforcement agencies to enforce the installation standards in their respective jurisdictions consistent with the installation standards of OMH; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of both parties to eliminate unnecessary duplication of inspections regarding installation standards within the Agency's jurisdiction;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual promises and undertakings herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

1. **Monitoring and Enforcement.** For the duration of this Agreement, the Agency will monitor and enforce the installation standards set forth in A.R.S. § 41-4004 (B) (4) and A.A.C. R4-34-102 as they apply to installation standards and accessory structures.
2. **Term.** The term of this Agreement shall be for five (5) years from the date of this Agreement.
3. **Standards of Performance.** In exercising the authority delegated hereunder the Agency shall perform to the same standards of performance that the law imposes upon OMH in exercising the authority described in section 1 hereof. In addition, the Agency shall not approve any installation unless the installer affixes a State Insignia of Approval as required by A.A.C. R4-34-802 (A) and pays to the Agency the fee established by OMH pursuant to the authority by A.A.C. R4-34-501 and as permitted by A.A.C. R4-34-506.
4. **Monthly Reporting.** The Agency in this Agreement shall submit a Monthly IGA Report to OMH. A copy of each closed mobile home/HUD manufactured home or FBB permit shall be

submitted with the monthly report. The monthly report with copies of permits shall be submitted by mail, fax, or email, on or before the 15th of the following month. OMH will provide the monthly report format which will require the following be collected and documented:

- a. ARZ HUD label number(s) or FBB manufacturers insignia number
- b. Unit serial number
- c. Installation insignia or FBB plan approval number
- d. Address of installation
- e. Date of approved final installation inspection

5. Fees Charged by the Agency. Permit fees charged by the Agency shall be the same as the Fee Schedule created by OMH pursuant to its authority under A.R.S. § 41-4010 (A) (4) and A.A.C. R4-34-501 and no more than permitted by R4-34-801(E). All fees collected by the Agency shall be kept by the Agency as compensation for the services performed by the Agency under this agreement. The Agency shall not be entitled to any other compensation for services rendered by it under this Agreement.

6. Termination. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time without cause by giving the other party thirty (30) days written notice prior to the date of termination. Additionally, OMH may terminate this Agreement immediately and without notice, if OMH determines that the installation standards required in the Agreement are not being maintained, or that local fees are not consistent with the inspection fees established by the Board of Manufactured Housing.

7. Qualifications of Personnel. The personnel that perform the functions delegated to the Agency in paragraph 1 hereof shall each have no less than one year of experience as a building code inspector or manufactured housing installation inspector.

8. Inspector Training. All Agency Inspectors performing under this Agreement shall participate in required initial and/or periodic training as set and coordinated by the State.

9. Duties of OMH. Should OMH require inspections of any portion of the installation of mobile, manufactured homes, accessory structures or factory built buildings not required by the Rules referred to herein and not covered under this Agreement, OMH shall be responsible for the inspections and enforcement thereof.

10. Notices. All notices shall be mailed or delivered to the party to receive such notice to the following address.

11. Interpretation and Amendments. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties hereto. This Agreement shall not be amended or modified in any manner, except by an instrument in writing signed by the parties hereto.

12. Headings. Headings are for convenience only and are not to be construed as part of this Agreement.

13. Invalidity of a Term. The parties agree that in the event any term, covenant or conditions herein contained should be held to be invalid or void, the invalidity of any such term, covenant or condition shall in no way affect any other term, covenant or condition of this Agreement.

14. Dispute. In the event of any dispute between the parties under this Agreement, the parties agree that they shall submit the dispute to arbitration pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 12-133(D) and 12-1518.

15. Inspection and Audit. Pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 35-214 and 35-215, all books, accounts, reports, files and other records relating to this Agreement shall be subject at all reasonable times to inspection and audit by the State of Arizona for five (5) years after completion of this Agreement. Such records shall be produced at the Auditor General's Office or such other office as the parties hereto may mutually agree within a reasonable time after request.

16. Conflict of Interest. The parties acknowledge that this Agreement is subject to cancellation by the Governor of Arizona pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-511, the provisions of which are incorporated herein.

17. Prohibition Against Discrimination. In the event that it applies, the parties agree to comply with the Arizona Governor's Executive Order No. 2009-09.

18. Governing Law and Venue. This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Arizona. The exclusive venue for any litigation, arbitration, administrative hearing or the like concerning this Agreement or any matter arising therefrom shall be in Maricopa County, State of Arizona.

19. Unavailability of Funding. Every payment or financial obligation of the parties under this Agreement is conditioned upon the availability of funds appropriated or allocated for the payment

of such obligation. If funds are not allocated and available for the continuance of this Agreement, this Agreement may be terminated by any party at the end of the period for which funds are available. No liability shall accrue to any party in the event this provision is exercised, and neither the OMH or Agency shall be obligated or liable for any future payments nor for any damages as a result of termination under this paragraph.

20. E-verify. To the extent applicable under A.R.S. § 41-4401, each party and its respective subcontractors warrant compliance with all federal immigration laws and regulations that relate to its employees and compliance with the E-verify requirements under A.R.S. § 23-214(A). Each party has the right to inspect the papers of the other party or its subcontractors participating in this Agreement and may result in the termination of the Agreement by a non-breaching party under terms of this Agreement.

**NOTICE OF INTENT
ORDINANCE O-16-05**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BISBEE,
COUNTY OF COCHISE, STATE OF ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF THE
BISBEE CITY CODE ENTITLED PARKS AND RECREATION; LIBRARY AND
PROVIDING FOR REPEAL AND SEVERABILITY**

WHEREAS, the City Code of Bisbee, Article 11.3.4, currently provides for payment of fines through U.S. currency only; and

WHEREAS, the Bisbee Fire Department wishes to collect cans for its annual holiday food drive with the assistance of the Bisbee Public Library; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the City Code is required to permit the collection of cans in lieu of U.S. currency in order to assist in the collection of cans for the Bisbee Fire Department's annual holiday food drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BISBEE, COUNTY OF COCHISE, STATE OF ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 11 Parks and Recreation; Library, Article 11.3.4 Fines and Collection Policies is amended to read as follows:

[] = Deleted Language

__ = New Language

A. Fines policies for overdue materials shall be as follows:

1. A fine of \$0.10 per day accrues beginning on the first overdue date for all items, except Interlibrary Loan materials. The charge for overdue Interlibrary Loan materials is \$1.00 per day. All fines are assessed per overdue item.

2. A maximum fine of \$5.00 per item applies to all items except damaged materials, materials with missing pages, or lost materials.

3. Materials returned within three days of the due date are exempt from fine levies. Materials returned after this three-day grace period will be assessed for the entire overdue period.

4. Any items, including out-of-print items, that are damaged beyond repair, missing pages or lost shall be replaced with equivalent copies or paid for in full by the borrower in accordance with the following fee schedule:

Hardback books	\$30.00
Paperback books	\$10.00
Children's hardback books	\$20.00
Audio books	\$75.00
Videos	\$35.00

A processing fee of \$3.50 per item shall also be paid by the borrower or patron.

5. Printouts shall be charged at \$.10 per page. Lost or damaged library cards shall be replaced for a fee of \$3.00.

6. Upon the approval of the Mayor and Council, the Bisbee Public Library may collect food cans in lieu of U.S. currency as required in Article 11.3.4(A)(1). Mayor and Council shall set forth the beginning and end dates for the collection of cans in lieu of U.S. currency. One food can is equivalent to \$1.00. The donation of food cans equivalent to the amount owed after rounding up or down to the nearest dollar will be sufficient to pay off a fine owed on a late item.

For example, if a patron owes \$3.20 on a late item, the patron may pay off the fine by donating three cans of food to the library, which after rounding is equivalent to \$3.00. If a patron owes \$3.50 on a late item, the patron may pay off the fine by donating four cans of food to the library, which after rounding is equivalent to \$4.00.

7. Article 11.3.4(A)(6), permitting the collection of cans in lieu of U.S. currency, shall not apply to fines incurred on damaged materials, materials with missing pages, or lost materials. For damaged materials, materials with missing pages, or lost materials, Article 11.3.4(A)(4) shall apply.

8. Article 11.3.4(A)(6), permitting the collection of cans in lieu of U.S. currency, shall not apply to patrons that have received more than two notices regarding an overdue item. Patrons who have received more than two notices regarding an overdue item will be required to pay the fine at the U.S. currency rates in subsections A(1) and/or A(4), above.

B. Collection policies for overdue materials shall include the following:

1. Four notices will be sent to patrons with overdue materials.
2. If, after two months and four notices, a patron does not return overdue materials, the overdue materials shall be declared lost and the patron shall pay the full replacement cost of the overdue materials in accordance with the fee schedule specified in Article 11.3.4 (A)(4).
3. The library shall exhaust, within reason, all possible avenues to recover severely overdue materials.

Section 2. All Ordinances, parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, or any part hereof, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, subsection or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by the decision of any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining portions hereof.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE

Section 1. Chapter 9 HEALTH AND SANITATION: AND CEMETERY, Article 9.5 FLOURIDE IN CITY WATER SYSTEM is amended to read as follows:

All persons, corporations or other entities operating a water utility in the City, for purposes of providing drinking water to the residents thereof, are hereby authorized and directed to provide the means and to proceed with the introduction of enough fluoride to balance [one] 0.7 (seven-tenths) of a part of fluoride to every million parts of water being distributed in the water supply system.

Section 2. All Ordinances, parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, or any part hereof, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, subsection or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by the decision of any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining portions hereof.

CHRONIC EXPOSURE MAY CAUSE MOTTLING OF TEETH AND BONE DAMAGE (OSTEOSCLEROSIS) AND FLUOROSIS. SYMPTOMS OF FLUOROSIS *INCLUDE* BRITTLE BONES, WEIGHT LOSS, ANEMIA, CALCIFIED LIGAMENTS, GENERAL ILL HEALTH AND JOINT STIFFNESS.

"AGGRAVATION OF PRE-EXISTING CONDITIONS:

POPULATIONS THAT APPEAR TO BE AT INCREASED RISK FROM THE EFFECTS OF FLUORIDE ARE INDIVIDUALS THAT SUFFER FROM DIABETES INSIPIDUS OR SOME FORMS OF RENAL FAILURE."

FIRST I NEED TO SAY THE VIEWS AND OPINIONS EXPRESSED HERE ARE MY OWN ~~AND NOT~~ ^{ALTHOUGH I WAS HEAVILY} ~~THOSE OF KBRP RADIO. HOWEVER,~~ I DO GIVE ~~KBRP~~ CREDIT FOR INSPIRING ME TO SPEAK UP, REGARDING RECENT ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE NEW CITY MANAGER.

UNFORTUNATELY, THERE IS A SENSE OF FUTILITY AMONG THE CITIZENRY THAT THEIR OPINIONS AND CONCERNS WHEN EXPRESSED IN OVERWHELMING NUMBERS ARE DISCOUNTED AND THEREFORE IT IS USELES TO TRY.

Not only did he misrepresent our meeting postponements, there were 2, not one, as he said, but he acted as if I had missed a so-called conference call that he never informed me about. He now has the employees terrified as well. All of the work Andy put into developing a high morale and upgraded workforce will be to naught if he continues as a dishonest despot.

I wonder if he will find some obscure law, as Jestin did, to forbid me from facilities oversight. At least I have Jestin's apology to me, after the fact, in writing.

Notice how quickly he shut me up when I asked about a state audit, which is free, to "benchmark protect" his position? Rather, without having read the documents of proof I previously provided him, he wants to consult with the lawyers at the risk pool who will charge us big dollars to review the case.

His basic rebuttal after our truncated meeting, postponed twice, without having read the history, was that since the Council approved it, my complaints of ARS violations were moot. I guess that should also cover suspicions of theft and embezzlement as well.

Single source and sole source contracting limits for professional services are clearly \$100k, (not the \$235K + illegal add-ons we paid PACE) I suspect that too many power folks had their fingers in the WWTP and Solar pie.

A credible party at the meeting with a 35+year Bisbee history confided that he believed that Klimek had a long time work history with Pace before he worked for us.
