PUBLIC COMPUTERS RECEIVE IMPROVEMENTS



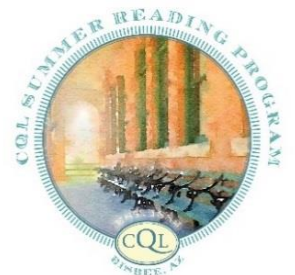
FRIENDS PURCHASE NEW PROJECTOR
