Forward an attachment or email any message to the printer's email: ricoh515303@printspots.com




When you submit a document to print, a private print release code will be emailed back to you. Please copy your release code and bring it to the front desk to enable printing.

PICKLEBALL RACKETS AND BALLS AVAILABLE FOR CHECKOUT




The Copper Queen Library has new pickleball rackets and balls available for check out, thanks to a generous donation from Sloane and Danielle Bouchever.

Patrons can check out a set of two racquets and six pickleballs.

Sets may be checked out for seven days and may be renewed if needed. Pickleball courts are located at Higgins Park in Old Bisbee, right next to the City Swimming Pool.


