

Britannica Library gives patrons access to the world's knowledge with accurate, nonfiction, cross-curricular content that's aligned to the next generation science, common core, and state curriculum standards. Information in Britannica Library stays accurate and relevant with near 1,200+ monthly content updates made by their in-house editorial team, which includes former teachers and educators. The database includes three levels of learning – Children, Young Adults and Adults – and provides a wealth of unique content to explore, appropriate for each researcher. Also included in the subscription is Britannica Escolar, which offers encyclopedia articles and research tools in Spanish and also features leveled searches for children and older learners. Bocce's origins date back to 5000 BC, where evidence of Egyptian cave paintings depict Nile Delta boys playing something that resembles bocce. Don't know how to play? Don't worry, the CQ Library's Bocce Ball Sets come with instructions on how to play and how to keep score. Sets are available at the front desk and may be checked out for seven (7) days.
