

**REQUEST FOR A PUBLIC RECORD TO BE USED
FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES**

Arizona state law requires that when a person requests copies, printouts or photographs of public records for a commercial purpose, the person must provide a statement setting forth the commercial purpose for which the public record will be used. A.R.S. § 39-121.03.

“Commercial purpose” means the use of a public record for:

1. the purpose of sale or resale of the record;
2. the purpose of producing a document containing all or part of the copy, printout or photograph for sale;
3. obtaining names and addresses from public records for the purpose of solicitation;
4. the sale of names and addresses from public records to another for the purpose of solicitation; or
5. for any purpose in which the purchaser can reasonably anticipate the receipt of monetary gain from the direct or indirect use of the public record.

Any person who obtains and uses a public record for commercial purposes without indicating the commercial purpose; who obtains a public record for a commercial purpose and uses it for a different purpose; or who obtains a public record from anyone other than the custodian of that record and uses it for a commercial purpose shall be liable for three times the actual damages in addition to other penalties provided by state law.
